

NVQ DECORATIVE FINISHING & INDUSTRIAL PAINTING OCCUPATIONS Level 2



- This qualification has been designed by the CITB to meet the specific needs of the construction industry. They are suitable for all those working in this specialised area and cover general requirements such as health and safety legislation as well as specific job-related skills and abilities.
- Employees can get their CSCS card on successful completion of the NVQ and the CITB Health & Safety test.
- This programme is delivered and assessed in the workplace. An assessor will visit the employees to develop a tailored training and assessment plan. Assessment is extremely flexible and is arranged in negotiation between the employer, employee and college assessor.
- Assessment time varies, but generally the qualification is completed within 3-6 months over 6-10 visits.

MANDATORY UNITS

- Conform to general workplace safety
- Conform to efficient work practices
- Move and handle resources
- Erect and dismantle access/working platforms

OPTIONAL UNITS

- Hang wall coverings (standard papers)
- Hang wide-width vinyl
- Install covering, centre-pieces and texture products
- Apply coatings by the airless spray method
- Apply coatings by the air spray method
- Produce broken colour work and basic stencilling
- Produce and apply complex stencil designs

PAINTER ROUTE

- Prepare surfaces for painting/decorating
- Apply paint systems by brush and roller

INDUSTRIAL PAINTER ROUTE

- Prepare surfaces for painting/decorating
- Apply paint systems by brush and roller

Plus one of the following for Industrial Painter Route

- Operate equipment in support of the paint sprayer
- Operate equipment in support of the abrasive blast cleaner
