## Brickwork



This course provides the learner with technical and practical brickwork skills. All candidates must sit and pass an external Health & Safety test to be awarded the NVQ qualification.

There are also external examinations for the Technical Certificate and Key Skills at Level 1.

### Brickwork Apprenticeship

To achieve this qualification, candidates must achieve all 5 mandatory units plus one optional units

#### MANDATORY UNITS

- Conform to General Workplace safety
- Conform to Efficient Work Practices
- Move and Handle Resources
- Erect Masonry Structure
- Set out Masonry Structure

#### OPTIONAL UNITS (any one unit of the following)

- Erect Masonry Cladding
- Lay Domestic Drainage
- Erect Thin Joint Masonry Structures
- Place and Finish Non-specialist Concrete
- Plastering and Render Surfaces
- Maintain Slate and Tile Roofing
