Plastering



This course gives the learner the skills of the plastering trade from basic to advanced. All candidates must sit and pass an external Health & Safety test to be awarded the NVQ qualification.

There are also external examinations for the Technical Certificate and Key Skills at Level 1.

Plastering Apprenticeship

To achieve this qualification, candidates must achieve all mandatory units plus listed optional units

MANDATORY UNITS (Solid Plastering)

- Conform to General Workplace safety
- Conform to Efficient Work Practices
- Prepare Background Surfaces for Plasterwork
- Produce Internal Solid Plastering Finishes
- Produce External Solid Plastering Finishes
- Move and Handle Resources

Plus two of the following units

- Apply Finishing Plaster to Background Surfaces.
- Install Direct Bond Dry Lining
- Lay Sand and Cement Screeds
- Apply Projection Plaster and Maintain Equipment
- Install Mechanically Fixed Plasterboard

MANDATORY UNITS (Fibrous Plastering)

- Conform to General Workplace safety
- Conform to Efficient Work Practices
- Move and Handle Resources
- Position and Secure Fibrous Plaster Components
- Repair and Secure Fibrous Plaster Components
- Repair Fibrous Plaster Components
- Produce Fibrous Plaster Components

Additional unit (not compulsory)

- Produce Cement Castings
