

Health and Social Care NVQ Level 3 (Adults)



This NVQ is for learners employed as health and social care workers in a supervisory role. Level 3 includes a pathway for adults and one for children and young people.

The **adult pathway** is appropriate for senior care workers, healthcare workers, home care organizers and community support workers.

Candidates must complete eight units in total.

Mandatory Units

- Promote effective communication for and about individuals
- Promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security in the working environment
- Reflect on and develop your practice
- Promote choice, well-being and the protection of all individuals

Optional units

- Contribute to care planning and review
- Contribute to planning, monitoring and reviewing the delivery of service for individuals
- Support individuals to access and use services and facilities
- Support individuals to develop and maintain social networks and relationships
- Support the social, emotional and identity needs of individuals
- Prepare your family and networks to support individuals requiring care
- Provide a home and family environment for individuals
- Contribute to the protection of individuals from harm and abuse
- Contribute to the prevention and management of abusive and aggressive behaviour
- Provide frameworks to help individuals to manage challenging behaviour

There are more than 50 additional generic units at Level 3 which can be incorporated into this NVQ

These programmes are delivered and assessed in the workplace. An assessor will visit the employees to develop a tailored training and assessment plan. Assessment is extremely flexible and is arranged in negotiation between the employer, employee and college assessor.

The duration of the programme varies, but ideally would be completed within 6-9 months
