

# NVQ CHILDREN'S CARE, LEARNING & DEVELOPMENT Level 2



This NVQ is designed to be applicable to anybody who wants to develop a greater understanding of the needs of children, organising activities and the regulatory and administrative functions of day care. This programme has been developed to meet with the National Occupational Standards for childcare, and constitute a vital tool for anyone working with children. The course is ideal for anybody working in a nursery or junior school environment or as a child minder and will provide you with relevant skills to perform your role more effectively.

**Learning Approach:** An assessor visits your place of work at a time convenient to you. Your dedicated assessor will support you throughout the duration of the course.

**Who Benefits:** This course is ideal for anybody who works with children that needs to meet the National Occupational Standards for childcare. The National Daycare Standards state that if we are to improve conditions for all children, all childcare settings need to have at least half of their non-supervisory workers trained to Level 2.

- This programme is delivered and assessed in the workplace. An assessor will visit the employees to develop a tailored training and assessment plan. Assessment is extremely flexible and is arranged in negotiation between the employer, employee and college assessor.
- Assessment time varies, but generally the qualification is completed within 3-6 months over 6-10 visits.
