

NVQ SOLID PLASTERING

Level 2



- This qualification has been designed by the CITB to meet the specific needs of the construction industry. They are suitable for all those working in this specialised area and cover general requirements such as health and safety legislation as well as specific job-related skills and abilities.
- Employees can get their CSCS card on successful completion of the NVQ and the CITB Health & Safety test.
- This programme is delivered and assessed in the workplace. An assessor will visit the employees to develop a tailored training and assessment plan. Assessment is extremely flexible and is arranged in negotiation between the employer, employee and college assessor.
- Assessment time varies, but generally the qualification is completed within 3-6 months over 6-10 visits.

MANDATORY UNITS

- Conform to general workplace safety
- Conform to efficient work practices
- Move and handle resources

BASIC SOLID PLASTERING ROUTE

- Prepare background surfaces for plasterwork
- Apply finishing plaster to background surfaces

Plus one of the following optional units

- Produce internal solid plastering finishes
- Produce external solid render finishes
- Install direct bond dry linings
- Lay sand and cement screeds
- Apply projection plaster and maintain equipment
- Install mechanically fixed plasterboard

FULL SOLID PLASTERING ROUTE

- Prepare background surfaces for plasterwork
- Produce external solid render finishes
- Produce internal solid plastering finishes

Plus two of the following optional units

- Apply finishing plaster to background surfaces
- Install direct bond dry linings
- Lay sand and cement screeds
- Apply projection plaster and maintain equipment
- Install mechanically fixed plasterboard
